During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online or paper will be as follows. 350 runs online (50%), 350 runs paper (50%). If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either one accordingly.

Limit of 10 dogs per envelope.

All entries must be submitted on official AKC Agility entry forms, one dog per entry form. Photocopies of entry forms without the AKC Agreement are not acceptable. Unsigned, incomplete, or illegible entries are not acceptable.

If you would like confirmation that your entry was received before the trial has closed, please include your email address or enclose a self-addressed stamped postcard.

Entries cannot be changed once the trial has closed. Please check your entries!

"After Closing" Waiting List

A waiting list (30 run maximum) will be maintained for this trial once it has closed on March 23. The waiting list will be active until its deadline — Monday, April 2, 6:00 pm CDT. Any runs that are entered in the trial at closing and pulled before the waiting list deadline will be replaced, if possible, by runs in order on the waiting list, and the exhibitor will be reimbursed in full. If a run is pulled but cannot be replaced, the exhibitor will not receive a refund and the dog will be considered absent for the run. Entry fees for runs on the waiting list that do not get into the trial by the waiting list closing date will be refunded in full.

Class Description

Please see the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for current class descriptions. **Dogs must** be entered only in Regular Classes or Preferred Classes with no crossover between them allowed at the same set of trials.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all Belgian Sheepdogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration or Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP). Dogs with a PAL/ILP number or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind, bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance are not eligible to compete. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Rules Applying to Registration and Discipline for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations, it includes both sexes.

Move-ups

Mailed/emailed moveups will be accepted until Tuesday, April 3 at 6 pm CDT. After that time, moveups for Tuesday must be submitted at the ABTC trial on Monday no later than 30 minutes after the end of the ABTC trial.

Change of Entry

As described in Chapter 1, Section 21 of the Regulations for Agility Trials, a dog which is entered in a Novice A class for which it is not eligible may be moved to Novice B. In addition, if notification has been received in writing from the AKC after closing that a dog is not eligible for a class entered, the dog may be moved to the correct class. The request for the move must be made at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial. If a VMO or Field Representative at a trial measures a dog into a height other than what they entered, the entry may be changed from Regular to Preferred or from Preferred to Regular, as long as the dog has not run any classes that day. If the dog has already run, the change may be made for the next trial day(s). The exhibitor must provide the Trial Secretary the AKC Agility Measurement Form when requesting the class change.

Volunteer Workers

Volunteers will be needed for the smooth running of this trial. We will have an online worker signup.

Trial Information

Setup time will be announced after closing. Trial hours are 7:00 am to 30 minutes after completion. Ring size: 85' x 110'.

Electronic timing will be used at these trials.

The building is climate-controlled. There is plenty of close parking and crate space. Please bring chairs and crates and water for your dogs.

Notice to Exhibitors

- The <u>safety of the dogs</u> is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.

The Belgian Sheepdog Club of America may cancel this event in extreme weather conditions.

- Entry fees will not be refunded if the trials cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Since <u>bitches in season</u> are not allowed to compete in AKC Agility Trials, the club will refund all but \$5.00 of the entry fee per run for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The Trial Secretary must receive <u>a statement from a veterinarian</u> of such a claim for refund by letter hand-delivered, emailed, or postmarked <u>at least 30 min before the trial commences</u>.
- For dogs sustaining an injury after closing, the club will refund all but \$10 of the entry fee per run. The Trial Secretary must receive <u>a statement from a veterinarian</u> of such a claim for refund at least 30 minutes before the trial commences.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- <u>All dogs must be on leash or crated</u> at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. The judge need not wait for any dog holding up a class. The Belgian Sheepdog Club of America has no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or steward for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought to the ring when required.

Entries must be made on Official AKC entry forms or copies and <u>must include the signed</u> <u>Agreement and Rules</u>. <u>Junior Handlers</u> must enter their JH# and complete back of form.

<u>Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms</u>, whoever may have made such errors. No entry will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. <u>Errors in entries made by the exhibitor cannot be corrected after the closing date</u>. No refunds for duplicate entries.

Dogs under 4 months of age are not permitted on the show grounds of AKC Agility Trials.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites and any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There is a <u>\$25 returned check fee</u>. Checks for cancelled or incomplete entries will be shredded. No check will be returned.

- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.
- Purina Event Center is open from 6:00 am to 10:00 pm.
- All buildings are NON-SMOKING and NON-VAPING. Smoking/vaping is permitted outside in designated areas.
- Dogs cannot be left in the Purina Farms Event Center over night.
- No one is permitted anywhere that is marked "Employees Only" and/or "No Admittance." These are separate divisions of Purina and not part of the show grounds.
- No baby strollers are allowed inside the building.
- No firearms are allowed on Purina property.
- The Belgian Sheepdog Club of America does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.



INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners ProgramSM may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?

High Scoring Awards

HIT Regular classes: All Belgian Sheepdogs competing in the Regular Standard agility classes, including all jump heights, shall be eligible for Agility High in Trial award. The High in Trial award shall be based on qualifying scores from the Regular Standard agility classes. A dog must have a Regular Standard Class qualifying score and have a time under Regular Standard course time to be eligible for the Agility High In Trial Award. Agility High in Trial will be awarded based on the following order of consideration.

- 1. dog/handler team(s) with a Standard score of 100 in the Master/Excellent class
- 2. dog/handler team(s) with a Standard score of 100 in the Open class
- 3. dog/handler team(s) with a Standard score of less than 100 in the Open class
- 4. dog/handler team(s) with a Standard score of 100 in the Novice class
- 5. dog/handler team(s) with a Standard score of less than 100 in the Novice class

In the event more than one dog/handler teams qualify for the High in Trial award, High in Trial will be determined based on the most seconds under Regular Standard course time. Seconds under Regular Standard course time is based on the Regular Standard course time minus the dog's time. If multiple dog/handler teams tie for the most seconds under Regular Standard course time, then a run-off will determine the High in Trial award. The course for the run-off is at the agility judge's discretion.

HIT Preferred classes: Same as HIT Regular Classes except substitute Preferred for Regular.

High Combined Regular Classes: All Belgian Sheepdogs competing in both a Regular Standard and Regular Jumpers agility classes, including all jump heights, shall be eligible for the High Combined award. The High Combined award shall be based on qualifying scores from the Regular Standard and Regular Jumpers agility classes. A dog must have Regular Standard and Regular Jumpers qualifying scores to be eligible for the High Combined award. High Combined will be awarded to the dog/handler team with the most points based on the points shown below.

- High Combined Points
- 30 points Master/Excellent qualifying score
- 20 points Open qualifying score
- 10 points Novice qualifying score

Should multiple dog/handler teams have an equal number of High Combined Points, High Combined will be determined based on the most combined seconds under course time for both Regular Standard and Regular Jumpers classes. Seconds under course time is calculated based on the course time minus the dog's time for both classes.


