This trial is open to all dogs six (6) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or are approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds.

Dogs with a PAL/ILP number or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf, bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance are not eligible to compete. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Rules Applying to Registration and Discipline for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

Wherever the word "doa" is used in these regulations, it includes both sexes.

- Since <u>bitches in season</u> are not allowed to compete in AKC Obedience or Rally Trials, the club will refund all of the entry fee per day for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The Trial Secretary must receive <u>written notification</u> from a veterinarian of such a claim for refund by letter hand-delivered, emailed, or postmarked <u>before the trial commences</u>.

No refunds other than bitches in season will be offered.

- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. - Exhibitors are responsible for being ready for judging when called to the ring. The judge need not wait for any dog holding up a class. 
