General Information

The obedience/rally trials will be held in the Great Hall (to the right if entering through the front entrance) in the Event Center.

Trial hours are 7:00 am to 30 minutes after completion of the trial. The building will open at 7:00 am.

No outside food or beverages (including alcohol) may be brought into the Event Center.

The Cairn Terrier Club of America does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for these events.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

The Cairn Terrier Club of America may cancel this event in extreme weather conditions.

Entry fees will not be refunded if the trials cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees or signatures or the "Agreement" on the reverse side of the entry form.

Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or by email or telegram prior to close of entries.

Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

A Recording Fee of \$0.50 is required for each dog and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 is required for each recordable single entry class at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial.

Canadian exhibitors must submit entries with checks drawn on US accounts or with International Money Orders in US Funds.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee for completing the transaction and/or reprocessing the entries to the amount of each returned check.

No refund for duplicate entries.

Checks for canceled entries will be shredded. No check will be returned.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.

Dogs allowed in rings during judging only.

Refund of 50% of entry fees for bitches entered in Obedience that come in season after closing date of this show may be obtained by sending a veterinarian's certificate to the Trial Secretary before the start of the show.

Food will be available at the Purina Checkerboard Cafe at the Event Center.

Parking — Exhibitor and visitor parking will be located on blacktop parking lots in front of Purina Event Center. Vehicles are limited to one parking space. No ex-pens or crates allowed on the blacktop but are allowed on the grass areas. No cones allowed in the parking areas. No parking in roadways or next to building.

Exhibitors & Guests — No one is permitted anywhere that is marked "Employees Only" and / or "No Admittance." These are separate divisions of Purina and are not part of the show grounds. No person or dogs allowed on the second floor of the Purina Event Center. There are no baby strollers allowed inside building. No cones allowed inside building. No firearms allowed on Purina property.

NO SMOKING or VAPING permitted in the Event Center.

Crates must be on matting that will not allow liquids or other substance to seep through on to the floor.

All dogs are to be on-leash at all times except when crated or as required to be judged.

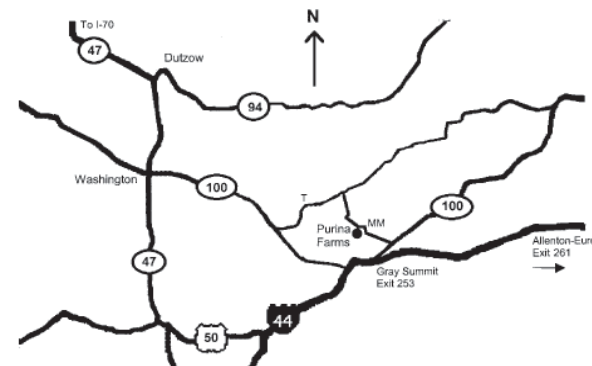
All exhibitors must be responsible for cleaning up after their dogs on the motel, RV and trial grounds. Motels require that dogs be crated when unattended. Any damages to motels, RV sites or the trial site can result in disciplinary action by the Event Committee. It is expected that exhibitors will clean up immediately after their own dogs and strongly encourage others to do the same.

All owners/exhibitors should be aware that the entire motel grounds and RV sites are considered within the trial grounds. You will be responsible for all damage to your room/site and may be subject to disciplinary action in accordance with the rules of the AKC. Any abuse of the grounds will be brought to the attention of the trial-giving club and its Event Committee. Any exhibitor's entries may be refused for previous misuse of the motel or RV facilities. This is an AKC supported measure.

Directions

From North/East/South: Take I-44 to Gray Summit/Hwy 100 Exit 253. Turn east on Hwy 100. After approximately ½ mile, turn left on MM at gas station. Entrance to Purina Farms is approximately 0.5 mile on left, just past the herding field.

From West: Take I-70 to Hwy 47, Exit 193. Take Hwy 47 south to Hwy 100. Continue on 100 to I-44 east. Take I-44 east one exit to Gray Summit. Follow directions above.
