All entries must be submitted on official AKC Agility entry forms, one dog per entry form. Photocopies of entry forms without the AKC Agreement are not acceptable. Unsigned, incomplete, or illegible entries are not acceptable.

If you would like confirmation that your entry was received before the trial has closed, please include your email address or enclose a self-addressed stamped postcard.

Entries cannot be changed once the trial has closed. **Please check your entries!**

Random Draw

Entries for the random draw will be accepted from Monday, Jan 11 at 8 am CST to Monday, Jan 25 at 6 pm CST. The drawing will be held on Monday, Jan 25 at 7 pm CST at the secretary's office, 632 N Forest Ave, Webster Groves, MO 63119.

A limited number of spaces will be set aside for workers by the Event Committee. If you would like to be considered for the workers' draw, you must check the WORKER box on the entry form (or write it in if using a different form). ALL entries in the same envelope must be worker entries. Those entering online can email the trial secretary directly.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or are approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds.

Dogs with a PAL/ILP number or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind, bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance are not eligible to compete. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Rules Applying to Registration and Discipline for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations, it includes both sexes.

Trial Limits Explained

Due to the restrictions at Purina Event Center, this trial will be divided into 4 GROUPS for entries and a limit of 40 handlers per GROUP will be allowed. The purpose will be to allow 40 handlers plus the support personnel in the building at all times. Those handlers and dogs will be allowed to stay in the building and run both their STD and JWW runs back to back.

Group 1 will be M/X 4", 8", 12", and 16" dogs.

Group 2 will be M/X 20", 24" and 24C" dogs.

Group 3 will be all Open/Novice dogs.

Group 4 will be Premier STD (Fri), Premier JWW (Sat) and T2B (Sun).

There will be a separate wait list for each group if the 40 handler limit is reached. There is no limit on how many dogs one handler may run in their group or how many groups a handler is in. For example, a handler with a Large M/X dog would be in Group 2 and could also be entered in Group 3 with their Open/Novice dog and could also be entered in Group 1 with both of their 8 inch M/X dogs.

Tentative Running Order/Start Times

Class Order - Regular and Preferred will be run together at each height.

Two rings, run sequentially.

Sunday Small M/X JWW / Small M/X STD — T2B — Large M/X STD / Large M/X JWW — Open STD / Open JWW / Novice STD / Novice JWW

All dogs competing in agility must **possess** an official AKC Jump Height Card. **You are not required to show your height card or send a copy with your entry. Move-ups

For the Friday trial: MOVE-UPS close at 6:00 pm CST, Monday, Mar 8. Move-ups may be sent by regular mail or email to the Trial Secretary. If an email address is provided with your entry, an email confirmation of the move-up will be sent.

For the Saturday and Sunday trials: MOVE-UPS close 30 minutes after the end of the trial on Friday and Saturday respectively and must be submitted at the trial.

Mailed/emailed moveups close at 6:00 pm CST, Monday, Mar 8.

Change of Entry

As described in Chapter 1, Section 21 of the Regulations for Agility Trials, a dog which is entered in a Novice A class for which it is not eligible may be moved to Novice B. In addition, if notification has been received in writing from the AKC after closing that a dog is not eligible for a class entered, the dog may be moved to the correct class. The request for the move must be made at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial. If a VMO or Field Representative at a trial measures a dog into a height other than what they entered, the entry may be changed from Regular to Preferred or from Preferred to Regular, as long as the dog has not run any classes that day. If the dog has already run, the change may be made for the next trial day(s). The exhibitor must provide the Trial Secretary the AKC Agility Measurement Form when requesting the class change.

"After Closing" Waiting List

A waiting list (30 run maximum each day) will be maintained for these trials once they have closed on Feb 24. The waiting list will be active until its deadline — Monday, Mar 8, 6:00 pm CST. Any runs that are entered in these trials at closing and pulled before the waiting list deadline will be replaced, if possible, by runs in order on the waiting list if the next dog's group has room, and the exhibitor will be reimbursed in full. **If a run is pulled but cannot be replaced, the exhibitor will not receive a refund and the dog will be considered absent for the run.** Entry fees for runs on the waiting list that do not get into the trial by the waiting list closing date will be refunded in full.

Notice to Exhibitors

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.

Gateway Agility Club of Suburban St Louis may cancel this event in extreme weather conditions. Entry fees will not be refunded if the trials cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Since bitches in season are not allowed to compete in AKC Agility Trials, the club will refund all but \$5.00 of the entry fee per day for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The Trial Secretary must receive written notification of such a claim for refund by letter hand-delivered, emailed, or postmarked before the trial commences.

The club will refund all but \$10.00 of the entry fee per day for injured dogs or handlers. Written request for a refund must be made to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of the first trial day and a veterinarian's or doctor's letter must be provided within one week of the trial.

THE CLUB WILL ALSO REFUND ALL BUT \$10.00 OF THE ENTRY FEE PER DAY FOR THAT DAY AND THE FOLLOWING TRIAL DAYS FOR HANDLERS WHO THINK THEY MAY HAVE COVID-19. YOU MUST CONTACT THE TRIAL SECRETARY BY EMAIL AT LEAST 30 MINUTES BEFORE THE START OF YOUR FIRST CLASS OF THE DAY. NO DOCTORS EXCUSE NEEDED. IF YOU ARE SICK, STAY HOME!!!!

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. The judge need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Gateway Agility Club of Suburban St Louis has no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or steward for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought to the ring when required.

Entries must be made on Official AKC entry forms or copies and must include the signed Agreement and Rules. Junior Handlers must enter their JH# and complete back of form.

All owners of mixed breed dogs must first obtain an AKC Canine Partners listing number before they may enter an AKC Agility event. The dog's breed name should be entered as "All American Dog". The dog's listing number must be entered on the entry form and "AKC No." checked.

Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may have made such errors. No entry will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Errors in entries made by the exhibitor cannot be corrected after the closing date. No refunds for duplicate entries.

Dogs under 4 months of age are not permitted on the show grounds of AKC Agility Trials. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites and any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

Gateway Agility Club of Suburban St Louis does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There is a \$25 returned check fee. No refunds will be issued for overpayment of less than \$12.

Checks for cancelled or incomplete entries will be shredded. No check will be returned.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.

All rights to televise, videotape, advertise, photograph, promote or otherwise exploit this event are vested with Gateway Agility Club of Suburban St. Louis, or in persons to whom assignments of such rights have been made in writing by the Club. Photographs and/or video recordings taken for any reason other than personal use are strictly prohibited. All exhibitors must comply with the Purina Guest Rules. Coronavirus Information and Guidelines

With the changing guidelines that are being required due to the Coronavirus, we are continually revising our plans for everyone's safety. Remember, despite all the plans we put in place, you still need to be aware of the basics: WASH YOUR HANDS AND WASH THEM OFTEN, MAINTAIN SOCIAL DISTANCING (AT LEAST 6 FEET), AND WEAR YOUR MASK AT ALL TIMES WHILE IN THE BUILDING.

Exhibitors must check in with Purina Security for a temperature check before entering the grounds.

There will be marked entrances and exits to the building. Exhibitors will be allowed to stay in the building during their classes with the schedule listed and the number of runs (and people) allowed at this trial. However, depending on the current state policy, it will dictate how many people will be in the building at any given time.

We will be using the the double fence (chute) for entry and exit from the ring. There will be no swing gate.

Masks (which you must provide) will be required while in the building at all time, including while you are running your dog.

There will be 6' distancing gates around timer/scribe/gate workers, judge and trial secretary. The jump bars will be disinfected during worker changes. The leash runner will have a grabber to move the leash; the grabber will be cleaned between workers. You may choose to wear your leash or put it in your pocket instead of leaving it for the leash runner.

No printed course copies will be distributed. We will have a few posted around the building so that you can take a picture of them. The trial secretary will also post them at <http://www.labtestedsecretary.com> the night before each trial and notify everyone by email. She will also post the running order, judge's briefing, trial chair's briefing and results. There will be no group judge's briefing, except for the Novice classes in order to answer any of their questions. The judge will be available during the trial to answer any questions.

No MACH/PACH parties may be held at this trial. You will not be permitted to eat inside the building. There will be food available in the cafe.

Our awards chairperson will prepare ribbons after the completion of the class. NO SELF SERVE will be allowed for a ribbon. If it is possible that you may get your MACH or PACH during this trial, please email Joan Braun at jb Braun@aol.com.

Bathrooms and door handles will be cleaned throughout the day. There will also be Porta-Potties available outside. Hand sanitizer will be provided at stations around the building. REMEMBER, WASH YOUR HANDS AND MAINTAIN SOCIAL DISTANCING.

People who are not feeling well and contact trial secretary at least 30 minutes before the start of the trial will be given the same refund as an injured/sick dog. No doctor's note is required. We will automatically cancel the following days runs also. You will receive that same refund for each of the remaining days to get over being sick. PLEASE, STAY HOME AND KEEP EVERYONE SAFE. People who are visibly sick and attend the trial may be asked to leave with NO REFUND.

The Event Committee has the right and ability to amend the premium as to the changing guidelines due to COVID-19 (CORONAVIRUS).

Gateway Agility Club of Suburban St Louis is doing all we can to make this trial safe and to comply with state and CDC guidelines; however, we cannot guarantee your safety and good health. If you are concerned about the possibility of exposure to the coronavirus, or if you are unwilling to follow the stated rules within, please do not enter this trial.

Trial Information

Setup time on Thursday will be announced after closing.

Trial hours are 7:00 am to 30 minutes after completion.

Ring size: 85' x 105' (2 rings).

Electronic timing will be used at these trials.

The building is climate-controlled. There is plenty of close parking and crate space. Please bring chairs and crates.

NO SMOKING or VAPING is allowed in the building.

Dogs may not be left in the building overnight.

No outside food or beverages (including alcohol) may be brought into the Event Center.

Changes Effective January 1, 2020

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A **separate entry form must be submitted** when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Fix and Go On (FNG)

As of January 1, 2020, Fix and Go On will be offered. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle and then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

For Exhibition Only (FEO)

FEO is not offered at this trial.

Prizes and Awards

Rosettes will be awarded to First Place through Fourth Place in each jump height in each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Dogs must qualify to receive placement rosettes.

1st place	Blue
2nd place	Red
3rd place.....	Yellow
4th place.....	White
Qualifying	Green

An AGCH rosette will be awarded to any dog finishing an AGCH title at these trials. A MACH rosette and bar will be awarded to any dog finishing a MACH title at these trials. A PACH rosette and bar will be awarded to any dog finishing a PACH title at these trials. A PAX rosette will be awarded to any dog finishing a PAX title at these trials. A new title ribbon will be awarded to any dog finishing a title at these trials. Dogs qualifying in both Master Standard and Master JWW at the same trial will receive a "Double-Q" award (value less than \$1).

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners ProgramSM may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?

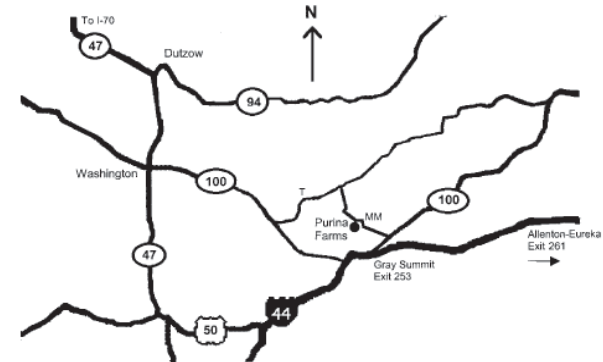
