"After Closing" Waiting List

A waiting list (30 run maximum each day) will be maintained for these trials once they have closed on Aug 5. The waiting list will be active until its deadline — Monday, Aug 10, 6:00 pm CDT. Any runs that are entered in these trials at closing and pulled before the waiting list deadline will be replaced, if possible, by runs in order on the waiting list, and the exhibitor will be reimbursed in full. If a run is pulled but cannot be replaced, the exhibitor will not receive a refund and the dog will be considered absent for the run. Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or are approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds.

Dogs with a PAL/ILP number or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind, bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance are not eligible to compete. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Rules Applying to Registration and Discipline for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations, it includes both sexes.

Move-ups

For the Friday, Aug 14 trial: MOVE-UPS close at 6:00 pm CDT, Aug 10. Move-ups may be sent by regular mail or email to the Trial Secretary. If an email address is provided with your entry, an email confirmation of the move-up will be sent.

For the Saturday, Aug 15 and Sunday, Aug 16 trials: MOVE-UPS close 30 minutes after the end of the trial on Friday, Aug 14 and Saturday, Aug 15 respectively and must be submitted at the trial.

Mailed/emailed moveups close at 6:00 pm CDT, Monday, Aug 10.

Change of Entry

As described in Chapter 1, Section 21 of the Regulations for Agility Trials, a dog which is entered in a Novice A class for which it is not eligible may be moved to Novice B. In addition, if notification has been received in writing from the AKC after closing that a dog is not eligible for a class entered, the dog may be moved to the correct class. The request for the move must be made at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial. If a VMO or Field Representative at a trial measures a dog into a height other than what they entered, the entry may be changed from Regular to Preferred or from Preferred to Regular, as long as the dog has not run any classes that day. If the dog has already run, the change may be made for the next trial day(s). The exhibitor must provide the Trial Secretary the AKC Agility Measurement Form when requesting the class change.

Trial Information

Set-up time will be announced after closing.

Trial hours are 7:00 am to 30 minutes after the completion of judging.

Ring size: 85' x 110' each (2 rings).

The arena is air-conditioned with indoor restrooms and bleacher seating. Please bring crates and water for your dogs and clean up supplies. Xpens will be allowed for 2 or more dogs but should be restricted to the minimum size required for crating.

No electrical devices are allowed due to overburdening of the electrical system. Batteryoperated devices are welcome.

Notice to Exhibitors

- The <u>safety of the dogs</u> is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.
- Greater St Louis Agility Club may cancel this event in extreme weather conditions.
- Entry fees will not be refunded if the trials cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Since <u>bitches in season</u> are not allowed to compete in AKC Agility Trials, the club will refund all but \$5.00 of the entry fee per day for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The Trial Secretary must receive <u>written notification</u> of such a claim for refund by letter hand-delivered, emailed, or postmarked before the trial commences.
- The club will refund all but \$10.00 of the entry fee per day for <u>injured or ill dogs</u>. Written request for a refund must be made to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of the first trial day and a veterinarian's letter must be provided within one week of the trial.
- The club will refund all but \$10.00 of the entry fee per day in the form of a club voucher for exhibitors who are absent due to a death in the immediate family.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. The judge need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Greater St Louis Agility Club has no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or steward for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought to the ring when required.
- Entries must be made on Official AKC entry forms or copies and <u>must include the signed</u> Agreement and Rules. Junior Handlers must enter their JH# and complete back of form.
- All owners of mixed breed dogs must first obtain an AKC Canine Partners listing number before they may enter an AKC Agility event. The dog's breed name should be entered as "All American Dog". The dog's listing number must be entered on the entry form and "AKC No." checked.
- Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may have made such errors. No entry will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Errors in entries made by the exhibitor cannot be corrected after the closing date. No refunds for duplicate entries.
- Dogs under 4 months of age are not permitted on the show grounds of AKC Agility Trials.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites and any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.
- Greater St Louis Agility Club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There is a \$25 returned check fee.
- No refunds will be issued for overpayment of less than \$12. Checks for canceled entries will be shredded
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.
- The front doors are to be used to enter/exit the facility. Side doors are for emergency use only. Electronic timing will be used at these trials.

COVID-19 Notice to Exhibitors

* Please read carefully *

Due to the state of Illinois guidelines pertaining to COVID-19, the following rules and procedures will be in place during the entirety of the trial. These procedures assume we will be limited to 50 people in the building at any one time.

There will be ONE entrance and ONE exit to the building. These will be clearly marked.

We will have room for all dogs to be crated inside; however, crating will be assigned by the Event Committee. Unentered dogs will only be allowed in the building if room allows, or you stack their crate with your entered dog(s).

The number of people allowed in the building will be limited, and the limit will be strictly enforced. Exhibitors will only be allowed in the building when it is their designated walk through and/or class run time. You may enter the building to use the restroom and to get your dog out of their crate during course builds and when the number of people inside allow for you to do so. Sadly, we will not be able to allow guests in the building. You will need to exit the building upon completion of your run to allow for the next group of exhibitors to enter.

Exhibitors will be required to wear a mask anytime you are in the building with the exception of when you are running the course or next dog on the line. You MUST provide your own mask.

We will not use the swing gate for ring exits. We will have the old style "exit chute". Please be sure to keep your dog under control and in the ring until on leash.

We will NOT provide a leash runner. All exhibitors need to carry their leash with them during their run. You may put your leash in your pocket or wrap around your body; however, if your dog grabs the leash at any time during your run, it will be scored an E and result in a non-qualifying score.

There will be a 6' boundary set around the Gate Steward as well as the Trial Secretary. Please respect these boundaries. ONLY the Gate Steward will be allowed to check dogs in, move dogs, etc. No one else should be touching the markers/pens.

We will not distribute printed copies of the course maps. Course maps will be posted outside and you can take a picture of them. They will also be posted at www.labtestedsecretary.com each morning. The running order, judge's briefing, Trial Chair briefing, and results will also be posted at www.labtestedsecretary.com

We will not be doing self-serve awards. Our Awards Chairperson will prepare your awards and you may pick them up 30 minutes after your class is finished running or later. PLEASE be sure to social distance at the awards area.

NO CONSESSIONS OR HOSPITALITY WILL BE PROVIDED. Please bring your own food and drinks. Please do not bring any snacks or MACH cakes, etc. to share.

PLEASE REMEMBER TO WASH HANDS FREQUENTLY AND PLEASE PRACTICE SO-CIAL DISTANCING.

The Trial Committee has the right to amend the premium as needed to adhere to any changing COVID-19 guidelines.

In the event we are unable to hold this trial due to changing state COVID -19 guidelines and need to cancel after the trial has closed, we will shred all checks.

Greater St. Louis Agility Club is doing all we can to make this trial safe, and to comply with state and CDC guidelines; however, we can not guarantee your safety and good health. Changes Effective January 1, 2020

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A **separate entry form must be submitted** when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Fix and Go On (FNG)

As of January 1, 2020, Fix and Go On will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle and then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
