If you would like confirmation that your entry was received before the trial has closed, please include your email address or enclose a self-addressed stamped postcard.

Entries cannot be changed once the trial has closed. Please check your entries!

Random Draw

Entries for the random draw will be accepted from Monday, Mar 15 at 8 am CT to Monday, Mar 29 at 6 pm CT. The drawing will be held on Monday, Mar 29 at 7 pm CT at the secretary's office, 632 N Forest Ave, Webster Groves, MO 63119.

A limited number of spaces will be set aside for workers by the Event Committee. If you would like to be considered for the workers' draw, you must check the WORKER box on the entry form (or write it in if using a different form). ALL entries in the same envelope must be worker entries. Those entering online can email the trial secretary directly.

"After Closing" Waiting List

A waiting list (30 run maximum each day) will be maintained for these trials once they have closed on May 12. The waiting list will be active until its deadline - Monday, May 24, 6:00 pm CT. Any runs that are entered in these trials at closing and pulled before the waiting list deadline will be replaced, if possible, by runs in order on the waiting list, and the exhibitor will be reimbursed in full. If a run cannot be replaced, the exhibitor will not receive a refund and the dog will be considered absent for the run. Entry fees for runs on the waiting list that do not get into the trial by the waiting list closing date will be refunded in full.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/ Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or are approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds.

Dogs with a PAL/ILP number or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind, bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance are not eligible to compete. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Rules Applying to Registration and Discipline for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations, it includes both sexes.

Crate & Chair Information

Please bring crates and water for your dogs.

Ground Covers (ie, tarps, crate mates, towels) are required under all crates. For the safety of everyone, all covers must be completely under your crates. Personal chairs must fit within your crate space.

AKC Jump Height Cards

All dogs competing in agility must **possess** an official AKC Jump Height Card. **You are not** required to show your height card or send a copy with your entry. You <u>are required</u> to mark on your entry form if your dog needs to be measured. For more information please visit http://www.akc.org/events/agility/jump_height_card.cfm

Change of Entry

As described in Chapter 1, Section 21 of the Regulations for Agility Trials, a dog which is entered in a Novice A class for which it is not eligible may be moved to Novice B. In addition, if notification has been received in writing from the AKC after closing that a dog is not eligible for a class entered, the dog may be moved to the correct class. The request for the move must be made at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial. If a VMO or Field Representative at a trial measures a dog into a height other than what they entered, the entry may be changed from Regular to Preferred or from Preferred to Regular, as long as the dog has not run any classes that day. If the dog has already run, the change may be made for the next trial day(s). The exhibitor must provide the Trial Secretary the AKC Agility Measurement Form when requesting the class change.

Move-ups

For the Friday, May 28, trial: MOVE-UPS close at 6:00 pm CT, Monday, May 24. Move-ups may be sent by regular mail or email to the Trial Secretary. If an email address is provided with your entry, an email confirmation of the move-up will be sent.

For the Saturday, May 29, and Sunday, May 30 trials: MOVE-UPS close 30 minutes after the end of the trial on Friday, May 28, and Saturday, May 29, respectively and must be submitted at the trial.

Mailed/emailed moveups close at 6:00 pm CT, Monday, May 24.

Trial Information

Trial hours are 7:00 am to 30 minutes after completion of the trial. The building is climate-controlled. Dogs may not be left in the building overnight. Electronic timing will be used at these trials. Setup time will be announced after closing.

Notice to Exhibitors

- The <u>safety of the dogs</u> is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.
- Greater St Louis Shetland Sheepdog Club (GSLSSC) may cancel this event in extreme weather conditions.
- Entry fees will not be refunded if the trials cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Since <u>bitches in season</u> are not allowed to compete in AKC Agility Trials, the clubs will refund all but \$5.00 of the entry fee per day for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The Trial Secretary must receive <u>written notification</u> of such a claim for refund by letter handdelivered, emailed, or postmarked <u>before the trial commences</u>.
- The clubs will refund all but \$10.00 of the entry fee per day for <u>injured dogs or handlers</u>. Written request for a refund must be made to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of the first trial day and a veterinarian's or doctor's letter must be provided within one week of the trial.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- <u>All dogs must be on leash or crated</u> at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. The judge need not wait for any dog holding up a class. GSLSSC has no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or steward for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought to the ring when required.
- Entries must be made on Official AKC entry forms or copies and <u>must include the signed</u> <u>Agreement</u>. <u>Junior Handlers</u> must enter their JH# and complete back of form.

Include only AKC titles on entries.

- All owners of mixed breed dogs must first obtain an AKC Canine Partners listing number before they may enter an AKC Agility event. The dog's breed name should be entered as "All American Dog". The dog's listing number must be entered on the entry form and "AKC No." checked.
- Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may have made such errors. No entry will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Errors in entries made by the exhibitor cannot be corrected after the closing date. No refunds for duplicate entries.

Dogs under 4 months of age are not permitted on the show grounds of AKC Agility Trials. Flexi-Leads are not allowed in the building.

X-Pens are not allowed in the building.

- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites and any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.
- GSLSSC does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There is a <u>\$25 returned check fee</u>. No refunds will be issued for overpayment of less than \$12.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.

All exhibitors are required to observe the policies of the Triune Training and Event Center. The policies are published at http://triunecanine.com/event-center/event-center-policies/. GSLSSC, their Board and Members, and Triune Canine Training and Event Center and

its employees will not be liable for any loss or injury which may be sustained through disappearance, loss, theft, communicable disease, parasites, injury and/or death of dogs entered in this event.

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A **separate entry form must be submitted** when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Fix and Go On (FNG)

Fix and Go On allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using Fix and Go On will result in a non-qualifying score. Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the run.

Entering for Exhibition Only (FEO) - Offered for FAST and T2B

FEO allows exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only offered in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/ or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (eg, when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring. Toys must be non-audible and may not leave the handler's hand. Toys that roll freely may not be used.
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and/or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.

• A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time.

CORONAVIRUS * * <u>Notice to Exhibitors</u> * *

Due to the state of Illinois guidelines pertaining to COVID-19, the following rules and procedures will be in place during the entirety of the trial.

The number of people allowed in the building will be dependent on the current state and local policies. There will be no outside spectators. The only individuals allowed in the building are volunteers, handlers, owners, co-owners, and parents of junior handlers.

There will be ONE entrance to the building, the door at the front. Exhibitors may use any of the exits from the building.

Crating will be pre-assigned. After closing, a crating signup link will be sent to exhibitors to allow them to choose their crating spaces.

We will be using a double fence (chute) for ring entry and a swing gate for exit.

There will be a 6' boundary around the gate steward. Only the gate steward will be allowed to check dogs in, move, etc. There will also be 6' boundaries around the timer, scribe, trial secretary and awards table. Please respect these boundaries and practice social distancing.

Masks/facial coverings (which you are to provide) will be required while in the building INCLUDING during your run.

A leash runner will be provided. The leash runner will use a "grabber" to move the leashes. You may choose to wear your leash or put it in your pocket per AKC rules.

No printed course copies will be distributed. Course maps will be posted inside the building. Course maps will also be posted at www.labtestedsecretary.com the night before each trial. The running order, judge's briefing, trial chair briefing and results will also be posted at this site.

If you park your vehicle in the back of the building, you will not be allowed to run your engine.

There will be no hospitality room. All food must be consumed outside of the building. Please do not bring any snacks or MACH/PACH cakes to share. There will be a food truck.

Our awards chairperson will prepare ribbons and awards after the completion of the class. NO SELF-SERVE.

People who are experiencing COVID-related symptoms, are self-quarantining or are involved in contact tracing for COVID exposure will be given a refund less \$15 per day. To receive a refund, you must contact the trial secretary 30 minutes before the trial begins. No doctor's note is required. Any runs for the remainder of the weekend will also be pulled. Please, stay home and keep everyone safe. People who are visibly sick and attend the trial may be asked to leave with NO REFUND.

The Trial Committee has the right to amend the premium as needed to adhere to any changes in the COVID-19 guidelines.

I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners ProgramSM may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.
