Trial Information

The building is **available for set up Friday, January 16, at 12:00 pm**. Trial hours are 12:00 pm to 9:00 pm on Friday and 7:00 am to 6:00 pm on Saturday and Sunday.

Walkthroughs and judges' briefings for the first classes will be at 1:30 pm on Friday and 7:30 am on Saturday and Sunday. Judging will start at 2:00 pm on Friday and 8:00 am on Saturday and Sunday.

The building is climate-controlled. There is plenty of close parking and crate space. Please bring chairs, crates and water for your dogs, and clean up supplies.

The concession stand will offer full breakfast and lunch on Saturday and Sunday.

Running Order

Class Order - Regular and Preferred will be run together at each height.

Friday: Excellent A & B JWW, Excellent A & B Standard

Saturday/Sunday: Ring 1 - Excellent A & B Standard, Open Standard, Novice A & B Standard, Novice A & B FAST; Ring 2 - Open JWW, Novice A & B JWW, Excellent A & B JWW, Open FAST, Excellent A & B FAST. Rings will be run simultaneously.

Height order - 26" to 4" all days

Move-ups

For the Friday, January 16, trial: MOVE-UPS close at 6:00 pm CST, Monday, January 12. For the Saturday, January 17, and Sunday, January 18, trials: MOVE-UPS close 30 minutes after the end of the trial on Friday, January 16, and Saturday, January 17, respectively. Move-ups may be sent by regular mail or email to the Trial Secretary. If an email address is provided with your entry, an email confirmation of the move-up will be sent.

AKC Height Cards

All dogs competing in Agility will be required to present an official AKC Jump Height Card prior to running in an Agility Trial. All dogs **except those jumping 24" or 26" (unless a VMO or AKC Representative is present)** without permanent or temporary height cards will be measured. **Sunflower Kennel Club will accept photocopies of the permanent or unexpired temporary height cards with the entry for these shows. Entries received without a copy of a height card will require that the card be shown or a measurement at the trial prior to picking up armbands.**

Electronic Timing

Electronic timing will be used at these trials.

Prizes and Awards

Ribbons will be awarded to First Place through Fourth Place in each jump height in each class. Qualifying ribbons and toys (value less than \$2) will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Dogs must qualify to receive placement ribbons.

1st place Blue
2nd place Red
3rd place Yellow
4th place White
Qualifying Green

Rosettes will be awarded to all dogs completing a title. Commemorative MACH ribbons and bars will be awarded to any dog finishing a MACH title at these trials.

All exhibitors must be responsible for cleaning up after their dogs on the motel and trial grounds. Motels require that dogs be crated when unattended. Any damages to motels or the trial site can result in disciplinary action by the Trial Committee. It is expected that exhibitors will clean up immediately after their own dogs and strongly encourage others to do the same.

All owners/exhibitors should be aware that the entire motel grounds are considered within the trial grounds. You will be responsible for all damage to your room and may be subject to disciplinary action in accordance with the rules of the AKC. Any abuse of the grounds will be brought to the attention of the trial-giving club and its Trial Committee. Any exhibitor's entries may be refused for previous misuse of the motel facilities. This is an AKC supported measure.

Directions to Trial Site

From north, east or west: I-70 toll road to East Lawrence, Exit 204. South on Massachusetts to 19th St. Left on 19th St to Harper St. Right on Harper St. Fairgrounds will be on left side of road.

From south: I-35 north to I-435 approximately one mile to Highway 10 West to Lawrence. Right on Harper St. Fairgrounds will be on right side of road.
