All entries must be submitted on official AKC Agility entry forms, one dog per entry form. Photocopies of entry forms without the AKC Agreement are not acceptable. Unsigned, incomplete, or illegible entries are not acceptable.

If you would like confirmation that your entry was received before the trial has closed, please include your email address or enclose a self-addressed stamped postcard.

Entries cannot be changed once the trial has closed. **Please check your entries!**

Random Draw

Entries for the random draw will be accepted from Monday, September 21 at 8 am CDT to Monday, October 5 at 6 pm CDT. The drawing will be held on Monday, October 5 at 7 pm CDT at the secretary's office, 632 N Forest Ave, Webster Groves, MO 63119.

A limited number of spaces will be set aside for workers by the Event Committee. If you would like to be considered for the workers' draw list, you must include a completed **Worker form** (last page of premium list) with your entry.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/ Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or are approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds.

Dogs with a PAL/ILP number or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind, bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance are not eligible to compete. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Rules Applying to Registration and Discipline for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations, it includes both sexes.

Trial Limits Explained

Due to COVID-19 concerns, this trial will be divided into 3 GROUPS for entries and a limit of 40 handlers per GROUP will be allowed. The purpose will be to maintain a limit of approximately 50 people in the building at any one time (40 handlers plus workers) Those handlers and dogs will be housed in the building and be able to enjoy their trial experience with others from their group. The groups will run both their STD and JWW runs back to back.

Group 1 will be M/X 4",8",12", and 16" dogs.

Group 2 will be M/X 20", 24" and 24C" dogs.

Group 3 will be all Open/Novice dogs.

There will be a separate wait list for each group if the 40 handler limit is reached. There is no limit on how many dogs one handler may run in their group or how many groups a handler is in. For example, a handler with a Large M/X dog would be in Group 2 and could also be entered in Group 3 with their Open/Novice dog and could also be entered in Group 1 with both of their 8 inch M/X dogs.

Sunday: Group 1: Small dog M/X JWW - Small dog M/X STD
 Group 2: Large dog M/X STD - Large dog M/X JWW
 Group 3: Open JWW - Nov JWW - Nov STD - Open STD

Move-ups

For the Friday trial: MOVE-UPS close at 6:00 pm CDT, Monday, Oct 26. Move-ups may be sent by regular mail or email to the Trial Secretary. If an email address is provided with your entry, an email confirmation of the move-up will be sent.

For the Saturday and Sunday trials: MOVE-UPS close 30 minutes after the end of the trial on Friday and Saturday respectively and must be submitted at the trial.

Mailed/emailed moveups close at 6:00 pm CDT, Monday, Aug 3.

NOTE: Moveups will be accepted into the M/X groups even if the groups are at the limit.

Change of Entry

As described in Chapter 1, Section 21 of the Regulations for Agility Trials, a dog which is entered in a Novice A class for which it is not eligible may be moved to Novice B. In addition, if notification has been received in writing from the AKC after closing that a dog is not eligible for a class entered, the dog may be moved to the correct class. The request for the move must be made at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial. If a VMO or Field Representative at a trial measures a dog into a height other than what they entered, the entry may be changed from Regular to Preferred or from Preferred to Regular, as long as the dog has not run any classes that day. If the dog has already run, the change may be made for the next trial day(s). The exhibitor must provide the Trial Secretary the AKC Agility Measurement Form when requesting the class change.

"After Closing" Waiting List

There is no after-closing waiting list for this trial.

Trial Information

Setup time will be announced after closing.

Trial hours are 9:00 am to 30 minutes after the completion of the trial on Friday and 7:00 am to 30 minutes after completion of the trials on Saturday and Sunday.

Ring size: 90' x 95'.

The building is climate-controlled. Please bring chairs, crates and water for your dogs, and clean up supplies.

Electronic timing will be used at these trials.

Notice to Exhibitors

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.

Show Me Agility Club of Central Missouri may cancel this event in extreme weather conditions.

Entry fees will not be refunded if the trials cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Since bitches in season are not allowed to compete in AKC Agility Trials, the club will refund all but \$5.00 of the entry fee per day for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The Trial Secretary must receive written notification of such a claim for refund by letter hand-delivered, emailed, or postmarked before judging commences.

The club will refund all but \$10.00 of the entry fee per day for injured or ill dogs in the form of a club voucher. Written request for a refund must be made to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of the first trial day and a veterinarian's letter must be provided within one week of the trial.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. The judge need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Show Me Agility Club of Central Missouri has no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or steward for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought to the ring when required.

Entries must be made on Official AKC entry forms or copies and must include the signed Agreement and Rules. Junior Handlers must complete back of form.

All owners of mixed breed dogs must first obtain an AKC Canine Partners listing number before they may enter an AKC Agility event. Dogs entered must list the breed name as "All American Dog" and not as a breed hybrid. The dog's listing number must be entered on the entry form and "AKC No." checked.

Include only AKC titles on entries.

Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may have made such errors. No entry will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Errors in entries made by the exhibitor cannot be corrected after the closing date. No refunds for duplicate entries.

Dogs under 4 months of age are not permitted on the show grounds of AKC Agility Trials. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites and any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

Show Me Agility Club of Central Missouri does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There is a \$25 returned check fee.

No refunds will be issued for overpayment of less than \$10. Checks for canceled entries will be shredded — no checks will be returned.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s) at the show site and at all hotels, motels, and campgrounds where they are staying while competing in these trials.

All exhibitors must comply with WestInn Kennels rules. The current fine schedule for soiling the turf at WestInn Kennels is posted at <http://www.labtestedsecretary.com>.

NOTES RELATED TO COVID-19

SMACCM expects exhibitors to be honest and only come in the building during the group they are actually entered in or assigned to work. The building will not be accessible to individuals outside their group time or to anyone who is not actually the handler of entered dogs. By adhering to these rules, everyone will be able to enjoy their trialing time and be assured that no more than 50 individuals are in the building at any one time.

All dogs may be crated inside but should only be taken in or out of the building by the handler assigned to the current group. Crating areas will be assigned after closing to ensure good separation for dogs and people present in each group. Un-entered dogs may be crated inside as space allows.

To maintain a good traffic flow while maintaining adequate physical distancing, the main double doors will be entry only. The north side door will be an exit door.

Exhibitors will be required to wear a mask at all times in the building **including when you are running the course**. You **MUST** provide your own mask.

Entry and Exit to the agility ring will be by swing gates, covered with a disinfectant-soaked towel.

A leash runner will be provided. They will use a mechanical "grabber" to transfer leashes. The "grabber" will be dunked in disinfectant between uses. Exhibitors may choose to carry their leash on their person during their run per AKC rules.

There will be a 6' boundary set around the Gate Steward, Trial Secretary, Judge's Table and the Timer and Scribe table. Please respect these boundaries. **ONLY** the Gate Steward will be allowed to check dogs in, move dogs, etc.

Printed copies of the course maps will be posted in several locations. Course maps will also be posted at www.labtestedsecretary.com the night prior to each trial. The running order, Judge's briefing, Trial Chair briefing, and results will also be posted at www.labtestedsecretary.com.

There will not be self-serve awards. Ribbons will be prepared and displayed on the awards table. PLEASE be sure to social distance at the awards area. If you only want your sticker, just remove it from the ribbon, recycle the ribbon(s) to the recycle basket. Those ribbons will not be used again at this trial.

NO CONCESSIONS OR HOSPITALITY WILL BE PROVIDED. Please bring your own food and drinks. Please do not bring any snacks or MACH cakes, etc. to share.

PLEASE REMEMBER TO WASH HANDS FREQUENTLY AND PLEASE PRACTICE PHYSICAL DISTANCING.

The Trial Committee has the right to amend the premium as needed to adhere to any changing COVID-19 guidelines or conditions. In the event we are unable to hold this trial due to changing state COVID-19 guidelines and need to cancel after the trial has closed, we will shred all checks.

SMACCM is attempting to make this trial safe and will comply with state and CDC guidelines; however, your safety and good health cannot be guaranteed. Your entry into this trial indicates you are in agreement to the rules put forth for this trial and that you cannot hold SMACCM responsible should you become ill following your participation in this trial.

I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners ProgramSM may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?

Prizes and Awards

Rosettes will be awarded to First Place through Fourth Place in each jump height in each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Dogs must qualify to receive placement rosettes.

- 1st place Blue
- 2nd place Red
- 3rd place Yellow
- 4th place White
- Qualifying Green

An AGCH rosette will be awarded to any dog finishing an AGCH title at these trials. A MACH rosette and bar will be awarded to any dog finishing a MACH title at these trials. A PACH rosette and bar will be awarded to any dog finishing a PACH title at these trials. A new title rosette will be awarded to any dog/handler team finishing a title at these trials. Each Junior Handler earning a qualifying score will receive an additional rosette. Dogs qualifying in both Master Standard and Master JWW at the same trial will received a prize (\$3 value).

Changes Effective January 1, 2020

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A **separate entry form must be submitted** when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Fix and Go On (FNG)

As of January 1, 2020, Fix and Go On will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle and then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

Worker Form

If you wish to be considered for inclusion in the worker draw, please indicate which positions you would be available to work. Due to the format of this trial, you must work the entire group, so you may not volunteer in any group in which you are running a dog. The only exception would be Course Building between the STD and JWW classes in Group 1 and between the STD and JWW courses in Group 2.
