Move-ups

For the Thursday trial: MOVE-UPS close at 6:00 pm CST, Monday, November 9. Moveups may be sent by regular mail or email to the Trial Secretary. If an email address is provided with your entry, an email confirmation of the move-up will be sent.

For the Friday, Saturday and Sunday trials: MOVE-UPS close 30 minutes after the end of the trial on Thursday, Friday and Saturday respectively and must be submitted at the trial.

Change of Entry

As described in Chapter 1, Section 21 of the Regulations for Agility Trials, a dog which is entered in a Novice A class for which it is not eligible may be moved to Novice B. In addition, if notification has been received in writing from the AKC after closing that a dog is not eligible for a class entered, the dog may be moved to the correct class. The request for the move must be made at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.

AKC Height Cards

There will be VMO's at these trials to measure dogs for AKC Height Cards.

IMPORTANT

The Open/Novice ring takes precedence over the Excellent rings, if you have a conflict. You must run your dog in your walkthrough group. If you are concerned about a conflict for walkthrough, please walk with an earlier jump height.

Trial Information

The building is available for general set up at 3:00 pm on Thursday, November 12. Anyone not a member of TAC or a designated volunteer who sets up before 3 pm will be moved.

Trial hours are 3:00 pm to 30 minutes after completion of judging on Thursday, 8:00 am to 30 minutes after completion of judging on Friday and 7:00 am to 30 minutes after completion of judging on Saturday and Sunday.

Ring size: 100' x 100' for Master/Excellent classes and Time 2 Beat; 75' x 115' for Open/ Novice classes.

The building is climate-controlled. There is plenty of close parking and crate space. Please bring chairs, crates and water for your dogs, and clean up supplies.

Concessions are available at the trial site during the day. On Thursday night, the club will provide pizza for exhibitors.

Notice to Exhibitors

- The <u>safety of the dogs</u> is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.
- Tri-County Agility Club of Missouri may cancel this event in extreme weather conditions.
- Entry fees will not be refunded if the trials cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Since <u>bitches in season</u> are not allowed to compete in AKC Agility Trials, the club will refund all but \$5.00 of the entry fee per day for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The Trial Secretary must receive <u>written notification</u> of such a claim for refund by letter hand-delivered, emailed, or postmarked before the trial commences.
- The club will refund all but \$10.00 of the entry fee per day for <u>injured or ill dogs</u>. Written request for a refund must be made to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of the first trial day and a veterinarian's letter must be provided within one week of the trial.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. The judge need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Tri-County Agility Club of Missouri has no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or steward for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought to the ring when required.
- Dogs under 4 months of age are not permitted on the show grounds of AKC Agility Trials.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites and any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.
- Tri-County Agility Club of Missouri does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There is a \$10 returned check fee.
- No refunds will be issued for overpayment of less than \$12.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.
- All rights to televise, videotape, advertise, photograph, promote or otherwise exploit this event are vested with Tri-County Agility Club of Missouri, or in persons to whom assignments of such rights have been made in writing by the Club.
- Photographs and/or videorecordings taken for any reason other than personal use are strictly prohibited.
- No SOLICITATION permitted on the trial site.
- Electronic timing will be used at these trials.

Vendors

Vendors should contact Penny McNiel, pbmacnboys@gmail.com. Vendor fee is \$25 (additional \$15 for electric) per day. All vendors must reserve space prior to the trial. Anyone found vending without a reservation will be charged double the vending rate per day.

Prizes and Awards

Ribbons will be awarded to First Place through Fourth Place in each jump height in each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Dogs must qualify to receive placement ribbons.

A jump bar, MACH rosette and tote bag will be awarded to any handler finishing a MACH title at these trials. A jump bar, PACH rosette and tote bag will be awarded to any handler finishing a PACH title at these trials. A PAX rosette will be awarded to any handler finishing a PAX title at these trials. Dogs earning a qualifying score in both Master Standard and Master JWW in the same trial will receive a key chain.

All exhibitors must be responsible for cleaning up after their dogs on the motel, RV and trial grounds. Motels require that dogs be crated when unattended. Any damages to motels, RV sites or the trial site can result in disciplinary action by the Event Committee. It is expected that exhibitors will clean up immediately after their own dogs and strongly encourage others to do the same.

All owners/exhibitors should be aware that the entire motel grounds and RV sites are considered within the trial grounds. You will be responsible for all damage to your room/site and may be subject to disciplinary action in accordance with the rules of the AKC. Any abuse of the grounds will be brought to the attention of the trial-giving club and its Event Committee. Any exhibitor's entries may be refused for previous misuse of the motel or RV facilities. This is an AKC supported measure.

Directions

From Interstate 70 - Take Highway 40/61 (Exit 210) east to Lake St Louis Blvd. At end of exit ramp, turn left (south) and continue 1.5 miles to National Equestrian Center.
