Limit of 10 dogs per envelope.

All entries must be submitted on official AKC Agility entry forms, one dog per entry form. Photocopies of entry forms without the AKC Agreement are not acceptable. Unsigned, incomplete, or illegible entries are not acceptable.

If you would like confirmation that your entry was received before the trial has closed, please include your email address or enclose a self-addressed stamped postcard.

Entries cannot be changed once the trial has closed. Please check your entries!

NOTE: Online entries will not be accepted for this trial.

"After Closing" Waiting List

A waiting list (30 run maximum each day) will be maintained for these trials once they have closed on Aug 5. The waiting list will be active until its deadline — Monday, Aug 17, 6:00 pm CDT. Any runs that are entered in these trials at closing and pulled before the waiting list deadline will be replaced, if possible, by runs in order on the waiting list, and the exhibitor will be reimbursed in full. If a run is pulled but cannot be replaced, the exhibitor will not receive a refund and the dog will be considered absent for the run. Entry fees for runs on the waiting list that do not get into the trial by the waiting list closing date will be refunded in full.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or are approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds.

Dogs with a PAL/ILP number or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind, bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance are not eligible to compete. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Rules Applying to Registration and Discipline for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations, it includes both sexes.

Crate & Chair Information

Please bring crates and water for your dogs.

Ground Covers (*ie*, tarps, crate mates, towels) are required under all crates. For the safety of everyone, all covers must be completely under your crates.

Personal chairs will be allowed in the building.

All dogs competing in agility must possess an official AKC Jump Height Card. You are not required to show your height card or send a copy with your entry. Move-ups

For the Friday trial: MOVE-UPS close at 6:00 pm CDT, Monday, Aug 17. Move-ups may be sent by regular mail or email to the Trial Secretary. If an email address is provided with your entry, an email confirmation of the move-up will be sent.

For the Saturday and Sunday trials: MOVE-UPS close 30 minutes after the end of the trial on Friday and Saturday respectively and must be submitted at the trial.

Mailed/emailed moveups close at 6:00 pm CDT, Monday, Aug 17.

Change of Entry

As described in Chapter 1, Section 21 of the Regulations for Agility Trials, a dog which is entered in a Novice A class for which it is not eligible may be moved to Novice B. In addition, if notification has been received in writing from the AKC after closing that a dog is not eligible for a class entered, the dog may be moved to the correct class. The request for the move must be made at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial. If a VMO or Field Representative at a trial measures a dog into a height other than what they entered, the entry may be changed from Regular to Preferred or from Preferred to Regular, as long as the dog has not run any classes that day. If the dog has already run, the change may be made for the next trial day(s). The exhibitor must provide the Trial Secretary the AKC Agility Measurement Form when requesting the class change.

Trial Information

Trial hours are 7:00 am to 30 minutes after completion of the trial.

The building is climate-controlled. Dogs may not be left in the building overnight. Electronic timing will be used at these trials.

Setup time will be announced after closing.

Notice to Exhibitors

- The <u>safety of the dogs</u> is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- <u>Entry fees will not be refunded</u> in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.
- Triune Agility Club of Southwest Illinois may cancel this event in extreme weather conditions. Entry fees will not be refunded if the trials cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Since <u>bitches in season</u> are not allowed to compete in AKC Agility Trials, the club will refund all but \$15.00 of the entry fee per day for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The club will refund all but \$15.00 of the entry fee per day for <u>injured dogs</u>. In both cases, written request for a refund must be made to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of the first trial day and a veterinarian's letter must be provided.
- THE CLUB WILL ALSO REFUND ALL BUT \$15.00 OF THE ENTRY FEE PER DAY FOR THAT DAY AND THE FOLLOWING TRIAL DAYS FOR HANDLERS WHO THINK THEY MAY HAVE COVID-19. YOU MUST CONTACT THE SECRETARY BY EMAIL BEFORE THE START OF YOUR FIRST CLASS OF THE DAY. NO DOCTORS EXCUSE NEEDED. IF YOU ARE SICK, STAY HOME!!!!!
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- <u>All dogs must be on leash or crated</u> at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. The judge need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Triune Agility Club of Southwest Illinois has no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or steward for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought to the ring when required.
- Entries must be made on Official AKC entry forms or copies and <u>must include the signed</u>
 <u>Agreement and Rules</u>. <u>Junior Handlers</u> must enter their JH# and complete back of form.
- All owners of mixed breed dogs must first obtain an AKC Canine Partners listing number before they may enter an AKC Agility event. The dog's breed name should be entered as "All American Dog". The dog's listing number must be entered on the entry form and "AKC No." checked.
- Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may have made such errors. No entry will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Errors in entries made by the exhibitor cannot be corrected after the closing date. No refunds for duplicate entries.
- Dogs under 4 months of age are not permitted on the show grounds of AKC Agility Trials.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites and any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.
- Triune Agility Club of Southwest Illinois does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There is a \$25 returned check fee. No refunds will be issued for overpayment of less than \$10.
- Checks for cancelled or unacceptable entries will be shredded. No check will be returned.
- Flexi-Leads are not allowed in the building. X-Pens are not allowed in the building.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.
- All exhibitors are required to observe the policies of the Triune Training and Event Center. The policies are published at http://triunecanine.com/event-center/event-center-policies/.

CORONAVIRUS ★ ★ Information You Need to Know ★ ★

With the changing guidelines that are being required due to the Coronavirus, we are continually revising our plans for everyone's safety. Remember, despite all the plans we put in place, you still need to be aware of the basics: WASH YOUR HANDS AND WASH THEM OFTEN, MAINTAIN SOCIAL DISTANCING, AND WEAR YOUR MASK.

There will be TWO entrances/exits to the building: the Entrance/Exit in the front of the building and one entrance and one exit in the back. Exhibitors will be allowed to stay in the building during their classes with the schedule we have made and the number of runs (and people) allowed at this trial.

Crate mats must be under all crates in all areas. Crating will be preassigned. After closing, a crating signup link will be sent to exhibitors to allow them to choose their crating spaces in a way that we can create distance between same-height dogs and handlers. Personal chairs may be brought into the building - each handler may also reserve 1 crate spot for a personal chair. Chairs must fit into the crate space. No extra chairs for spouses or extra owners will be allowed in the crating reservations unless there are available spaces. There will be no sharing of open chairs at this time.

We will be using the old style of entry and exit from the ring — the double fence (chute). There will be NO SWING GATE. Practice your recalls.

Masks/facial coverings (which you must provide) will be required while in the building with the exception that you may choose not to wear your mask while waiting at the gate or during your run. You will need to put the mask back on after your run. Masks will be optional for the scribe, timer, ring crew, secretary and judge once they are in position. There will be 6' distancing gates around timer/scribe/gate workers.

The jump bars will be disinfected during worker changes. The leash runner will have a grabber to move the leash; the grabber will be cleaned between workers. You may choose to wear your leash or put it in your pocket instead of leaving it for the leash runner.

Bathrooms and door handles will be cleaned throughout the day. Hand sanitizer will be provided by the club and be in stations around the building. BUT REMEMBER, WASH YOUR HANDS AND MAINTAIN SOCIAL DISTANCING

No printed course copies will be distributed. We will have a few posted outside the building so that you can take a picture of them. The trial secretary will also post them at http://www.labtestedsecretary.com the night before each trial and notify everyone by email. She will also post the running order, judge's briefing, trial chair's briefing and results. There will be no group judge's briefing, except for the Novice classes to answer any of their questions. The general information will be posted. The judge will be available during the trial to answer any questions. Our plan is to do a FACEBOOK live feed during the trial, so you can be aware of which class is running. Announcements will be made throughout the day to keep you updated.

If you park your car in the back of the building, you will not be allowed to run your car engine while there. If you want to do this, you will need to park in the front parking lot.

A food truck will be available for purchase of lunches. There are also many restaurants within 5 minutes. There will be no worker hospitality room or MACH/PACH parties at this trial.

Our awards chairperson will prepare ribbons after the completion of the class. NO SELF SERVE will be allowed for ribbons.

People who are not feeling well and contact trial secretary before the start of the trial will be given the same refund as an injured dog. No doctor's note is required. We will automatically cancel the following days runs also. You will receive that same refund for each of the remaining days to get over being sick. PLEASE, STAY HOME AND KEEP EVERYONE SAFE. People who are visibly sick and attend the trial may be asked to leave with NO REFUND.

The trial committee has the right and ability to amend the premium as to the changing guidelines due to COVID-19 (CORONAVIRUS).

YES, LOTS OF RULES, BUT WE ARE DOING OUR BEST TO KEEP THE ENVIRONMENT AS SAFE AS POSSIBLE WHILE STILL GETTING TO RUN OUR DOGS.

Changes Effective January 1, 2020

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A **separate entry form must be submitted** when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Fix and Go On (FNG)

As of January 1, 2020, Fix and Go On will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle and then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

For Exhbition Only (FEO)

FFO is not offered at this trial

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners ProgramSM may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767.
