Paper entries received within the first 24 hours must include postage or be metered. Entries must be delivered by multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS, and DHL. You must waive the signature requirement for delivery services, if applicable.

Limit of 10 dogs per envelope. No hand deliveries can be accepted in the first 24 hours. All entries must be submitted on official AKC Agility entry forms, one dog per entry form. Photocopies of entry forms without the AKC Agreement are not acceptable. Unsigned, incomplete, or illegible entries are not acceptable.

If you would like confirmation that your entry was received before the trial has closed, please include your email address or enclose a self-addressed stamped postcard.

Entries cannot be changed once the trial has closed. **Please check your entries!**

"After Closing" Waiting List

A waiting list (30 run maximum) will be maintained for this trial once it has closed on March 20. The waiting list will be active until its deadline — Monday, April 1, 6:00 pm CDT. Any runs that are entered in this trial at closing and pulled before the waiting list deadline will be replaced, if possible, by runs in the order on the waiting list, and the exhibitor will be reimbursed in full. **If a run is pulled but cannot be replaced, the exhibitor will not receive a refund and the dog will be considered absent for the run.** Entry fees for runs on the waiting list that do not get into the trial by the waiting list closing date will be refunded in full.

Worker Raffle

There will be a raffle for everyone who volunteers to work at the trial. Please consider bringing a donation for the agility workers' raffle to help increase the fun.

Class Description

Please see the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for current class descriptions. **Dogs must be entered only in Regular Classes or Preferred Classes with no crossover between them allowed at the same set of trials.**

Dogs Eligible to Enter

These trials are open to Standard Schnauzers fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration or Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP). Dogs with a PAL/ILP number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind, bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance are not eligible to compete. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Rules Applying to Registration and Discipline for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations, it includes both sexes.

All dogs competing in agility must **possess** an official AKC Jump Height Card. **You are not required to show your height card or send a copy with your entry. Move-ups

For the Thursday trial: MOVE-UPS close at 6:00 pm CDT, April 1. Move-ups may be sent by regular mail or email to the Trial Secretary. If an email address is provided with your entry, an email confirmation of the move-up will be sent.

For the Friday and Saturday trials: MOVE-UPS close 30 minutes after the end of the trial on Thursday, Apr 4 and Friday, Apr 5 respectively and must be submitted at the trial.

Change of Entry

As described in Chapter 1, Section 21 of the Regulations for Agility Trials, a dog which is entered in a Novice A class for which it is not eligible may be moved to Novice B. In addition, if notification has been received in writing from the AKC after closing that a dog is not eligible for a class entered, the dog may be moved to the correct class. The request for the move must be made at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial. If a VMO or Field Representative at a trial measures a dog into a height other than what they entered, the entry may be changed from Regular to Preferred or from Preferred to Regular, as long as the dog has not run any classes that day. If the dog has already run, the change may be made for the next trial day(s). The exhibitor must provide the Trial Secretary the AKC Agility Measurement Form when requesting the class change.

Trial Information

The agility crating area will officially be open for setup on Tuesday, Apr 2 at 4 pm.

Trial hours are 6:30 am until 30 minutes after the completion of judging.

Ring size: 90' x 100'.

The Event Center is air-conditioned with indoor restrooms. Please bring crates and water for your dogs and clean up supplies.

Limited crating space is available near the agility ring. Protective mats must be under all crates. Please conserve space by double-stacking crates where practical. The Agility Event Committee reserves the right to condense crating space.

Food service is available at the trial site. Only small coolers for treats are allowed; no other outside food is permitted.

Electronic timing will be used at these trials.

Notice to Exhibitors

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

The Standard Schnauzer Club of America may cancel this event in extreme weather conditions. Entry fees will not be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.

Since bitches in season are not allowed to compete in AKC Agility Trials, entry fees less \$5 per class/run entered will be refunded by the club. The Trial Secretary must receive written notification of such a claim for refund by letter or email before the trial commences. Written verification from a veterinarian and a copy of the final Trial Confirmation is required and must be RECEIVED no later than 48 hours after end of the trial.

Refunds for changes in entries made before closing will be subject to a \$5.00 processing fee. All refunds will be mailed after the specialty.

No refunds will be given for entries withdrawn after closing in the event a dog and/or handler are injured or absent.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. The judge need not wait for any dog holding up a class. The Standard Schnauzer Club of America has no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or steward for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought to the ring when required. Entries must be made on Official AKC entry forms or copies and must include the signed Agreement and Rules. Junior Handlers must enter their JH# and complete back of form. Include only AKC titles on entries.

Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, regardless of whoever may have made such errors. No entry will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Errors in entries made by the exhibitor cannot be corrected after the closing date. No refunds for duplicate entries.

Dogs under 4 months of age are not permitted on the show grounds of AKC Agility Trials. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites and any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There is a \$25 returned check fee.

No refunds will be issued for overpayment of less than \$10.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.

The Standard Schnauzer Club of America, its Boards and Members, and Nestlé Purina Farms and its employees will not be liable for any loss or injury which may be sustained through disappearance, loss, theft, communicable disease, parasites, injury and/or death of dogs entered in this event.

Purina Event Center is open from 6:00 am to 10:00 pm.

All buildings are NON-SMOKING. Smoking is permitted outside in designated areas.

No spectators or dogs are allowed on the second floor of the Purina Event Center.

No firearms are allowed on Purina property.

All Purina prizes, if not awarded in the ring, must be picked up during the event at the Pro Plan booth. Presentation of the winning ribbon is required. Purina reserves the right to make prize substitutions of equal or greater value in the event a specific listed prize is not available.

High Scoring Standard Schnauzer will be awarded each day to the Standard Schnauzer from the Standard and JWW classes with the highest qualifying score. If there is more than one dog that meets this criterion, the award will go to the dog with the fastest yards per second, with the Standard yards per second calculated by subtracting 5 seconds from the Standard time and then dividing by the course yardage.

High Scoring Junior Handler will be determined using the above definition. Junior handlers must have an AKC JH#.

Time 2 Beat Regular Winner is the dog in Regular T2B with the greatest seconds under SCT.
Time 2 Beat Preferred Winner is the dog in Preferred T2B with the greatest seconds under SCT.

NOTE: Only dogs entered in Regular 20" and 16" and Preferred 16" and 12" jump heights are eligible for these prizes.

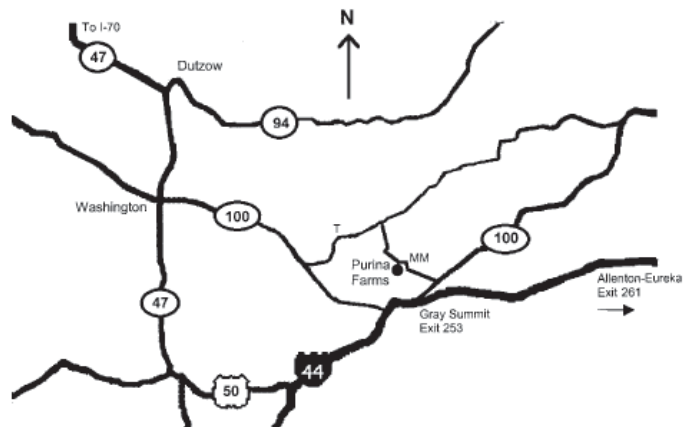

The Live to Run Again Campaign was founded and launched by Tail Blazers Agility Club in memory of Jane Callaghy, one of its founding members. The Campaign is now a non-profit organization in Pennsylvania dedicated to national public education about drowsy driving.

On the afternoon of April 1, 2001, while returning from a competition, an admired agility competitor and dog enthusiast died in a tragic auto accident when the driver of her vehicle fell asleep at the wheel. Out of this terrible, and preventable, tragedy emerged the LRA Campaign, which is a volunteer-driven organization committed to raising awareness of the importance of driving alert and rested.

Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners ProgramSM may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

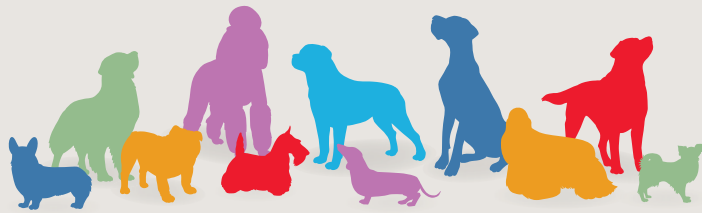
