A separate entry blank must be completed for each dog entered. Please use care in clearly indicating which days, classes, courses (A or B) and stock you wish to enter for each dog. Entries for a maximum of ten (10) dogs are allowed in each envelope, regardless of the number of classes entered. Envelopes containing entries for more than ten dogs will be treated as invalid entries and returned.

Confirmation of entry will be sent via email if an email address is included on the entry form. General Specialty entry fee policies can be found in the General Information Brochure.

Random Draw

Random Draw Opening Date: Wednesday, July 14, 2010.

Random Draw Closing Date: Saturday, August 7, 2010 at 6:00 pm CDT.

Random Draw will be held on Sunday, August 8 at 7:00 pm CDT at the Secretary's office.

A random draw of entries will take place only if the number of entries received by August 7, 2010 exceeds the maximum number of runs offered.

All entries will be opened prior to the draw and checked for accuracy. Duplicate entries for the same dog will be returned. Entries for a maximum of ten (10) dogs are allowed in each envelope, regardless of the number of classes entered. Envelopes containing entries for more than ten dogs will be treated as invalid entries and returned. In the event that an envelope drawn contains more entries than runs available, a draw will be conducted among the entries in that envelope. If necessary, a draw for an alternates' list will be held from the remaining entries after limits have been reached. After the draw, entries will be accepted on a First Received basis.

Event Details

Entries open at 8:00 am CDT, Wednesday, July 14, 2010.

Entries close at 6:00 pm CDT, Wednesday, September 8, 2010 or when limits are reached, after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled, altered, or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.

The outrun length for B course will be 150 feet for Started, 300 feet for Intermediate, and 600 feet for Advanced.

Livestock

Sheep: Katahdin/Barbado cross. Value: \$125.00 per head. There will be four head per run on A course and five head per run on B course and in all test classes.

Ducks: Call. Value: \$50.00 per head. There will be five head per run in all classes and on all courses.

Notice to Exhibitors

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.

The Border Collie Society of America may cancel this event in extreme weather conditions.

Entry fees will not be refunded if the events cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Bitches in season will be permitted to run but will be moved to the end of the running order in Test Classes. Please notify the Event Secretary if your bitch is in season

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There is a \$20 returned check fee.

No refunds will be issued for overpayment of less than \$10.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the event site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. The judge need not wait for any dog holding up a class. The Border Collie Society of America has no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or steward for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought to the ring when required.

Entries must be made on Official AKC entry forms or copies and must include the signed Agreement and Rules.

Include only AKC titles on entries.

Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may have made such errors. No entry will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Errors in entries made by the exhibitor cannot be corrected after the closing date. No refunds for duplicate entries.

Dogs under 6 months of age are not permitted on the show grounds of AKC events.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites and any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

The Border Collie Society of America does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

Entry fees will be refunded to alternates who decline to be placed on the alternate list. Entry fees of alternates who do not participate in the test or trial will be refunded. Entry fees will not be refunded to a scheduled entrant who is absent on the day of the event unless an alternate is present and runs in the place of the absent dog.

A tub for cooling off will be provided.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.

Dogs may not be left unattended in the Event Center overnight. Dogs may not be left in closed vehicles without proper ventilation. If dogs are found in distress, BCSA will take appropriate action.

No professional photography or videotaping is permitted without permission.

No gasoline or diesel generators are permitted within 100 feet of the ring.

No alcoholic beverages are allowed at the event site.

NO SMOKING is allowed in the Purina Event Center.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

These events are open to Border Collies which have been registered with the American Kennel Club or have been granted a PAL/ILP number and are nine (9) months of age or older.

Move-up Information

Dogs shall be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for herding title, provided that the request is made to the Event Secretary no later than one-half hour before the start of the trial and that there are open runs available in the class. Email notice is acceptable.
